

Guaranteed Admission Agreement
For
Virginia Community College System
Associate of Applied Science in Early Childhood
Development or Early Childhood Education
AND
Old Dominion University
Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education

I. Introduction

Old Dominion University (ODU) and the Virginia Community College System (VCCS), recognizing the need to facilitate the admission of transfer students from Virginia's community colleges to ODU as they pursue a baccalaureate degree in Early Childhood Development or Early Childhood Education, resolve to adopt a

Guaranteed Admission Agreement (GAA). This agreement provides a pathway for students to progress from the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) in Early Childhood Development or Early Childhood Education degree directly to the Bachelor of Science (B.S.) in Early Childhood Education. VCCS students who do not meet the

eligibility terms described herein may still apply and will be considered for admission, although admission is not guaranteed.

Definitions:

"ODU program" refers to ODU's B.S. in Early Childhood Education.

"VCCS program" refers to the A.A.S. in Early Childhood Development or the A.A.S. in Early Childhood
